- Strengthen and secure the land base of the Conservancies of natural spaces
- Develop communication with the public and promote the network of managed sites
- Accompany the network in the implementation of the ERC sequence
- Supporting the territories for better consideration of biodiversity
- Contribute to the technical and legal support of the network

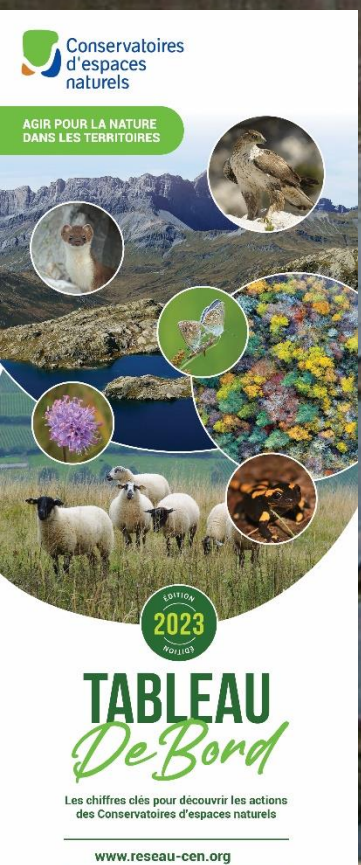
