

## LIFE NATURARMY

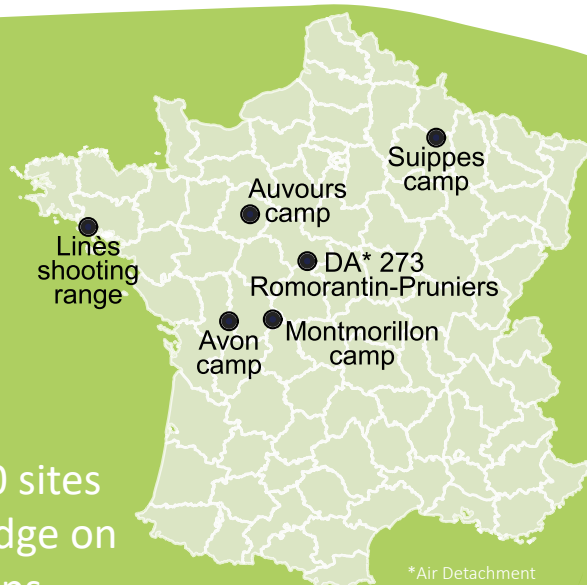
A partnership between the French ministry of Defence, the Federation of Natural Areas Conservancies and the University of Brest

**275,000 ha** of military land in France  
**44,486 ha** of military land included in the Natura 2000 network

Characterise the specificities of Natura 2000 sites under military control by improving knowledge on habitats and species on French military camps

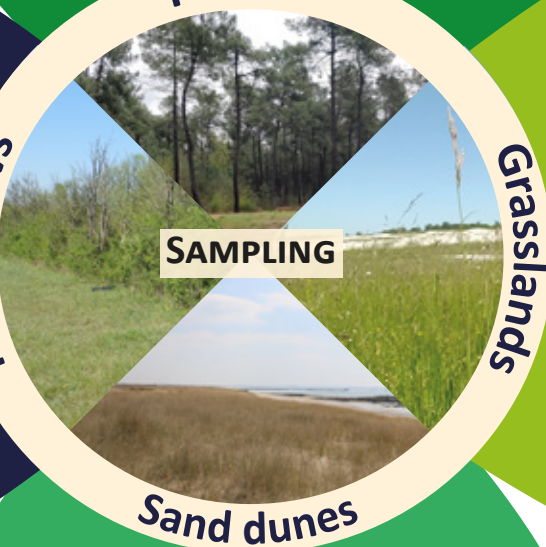

The habitats studied in this program are in **good and medium conservation status**. Overall, their conservation status are **similar or slightly better** than similar sites under non-military management
